FY 2011 HUD Community Challenge Planning Grant Application

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has funds available for local governments with populations of less than 50,000 to foster reform and reduce barriers to achieving affordable, economically viable, and sustainable communities; *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma desires to apply for a HUD Community Challenge Planning Grant to begin planning for the much needed revitalization of Selma's neighborhoods; *and*

WHEREAS, the total estimated planning cost is \$550,000.00. The City desires to seek \$450,000.00 in HUD grant funds and provide the required 20% local cash match of approximately \$100,000.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama that:

George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development requesting \$550,000.00 in grant funds and to place the required \$100,000.00 local match in the FY 2012 Grant Match budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that George Evans, in his official capacity as Mayor is authorized to sign all appropriate letters, forms and documents necessary for the submission of this grant application.


